#### ITALY RAVELLO, AMALFI COAST VILLA CIMBRONE

Clinging vertiginously to the mountains of the dramatic Amalfi coastline, perched atop the craggy hillside town of Ravello, Villa Cimbrone, with its magical gardens, has for centuries welcomed travellers in through its ancient doors. Once a private villa, acquired by English aristocrat Lord Grimthorpe in 1904, today the Cimbrone is a 19-bedroom hotel, while still retaining the discreet air of a family home. Plump for the Greta Garbo suite, the setting of the reclusive Hollywood star's trysts with Leopold Stokowski, which enjoys panoramic views of the gardens and the coast below, or opt for the whimsical Camelia suite lodged in the crypt's courtyard, featuring a vast frescoed ceiling and fullheight windows. Every room combines the traditional features of a patrician villa with widescreen TVs, wireless internet connection and sumptuous linen bedding. Fresh produce grown in the Cimbrone's herb and vegetable cardens feature in inventive dishes served at the terraced restaurant under the watchful eye of head chef Alberto Annarumma. Highlights include sublime stir-fried turbot with potatoes. capers and spices, and a 'sandwich' of red mullet with baby spinach and bulli (sea snail) sauce. Pasta lovers will enjoy paccheri with oxtail and an Amalfi lemon salad. Don't miss the fine local wines - Fiano di Avellino and Greco di Tufo are just two that have gamered an international reputation. Fresh home-made preserves adom the breakfast table - try the delicate wisteria jam before taking a leisurely stroll to the belivedere terrace to absorb the unfeasibly sheer drop to the sparkling Mediterranean below.

Why go? To feast on fabulous fresh food and admire stunning coastal views.
